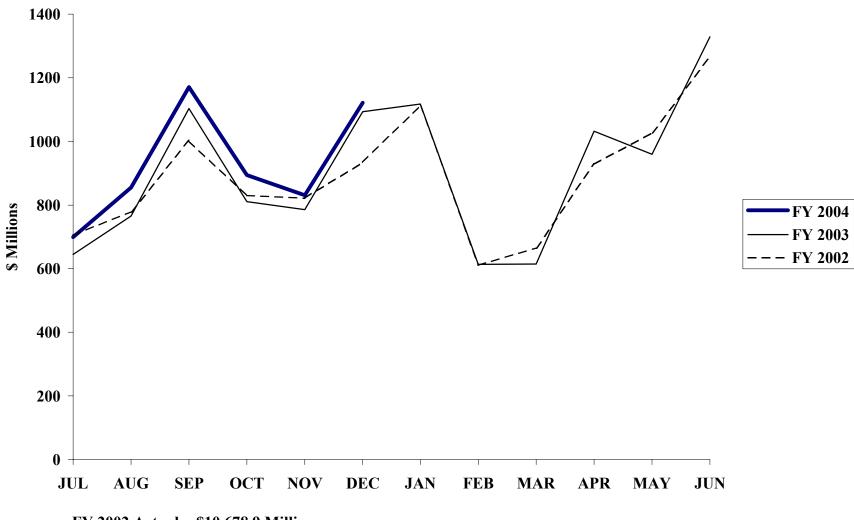

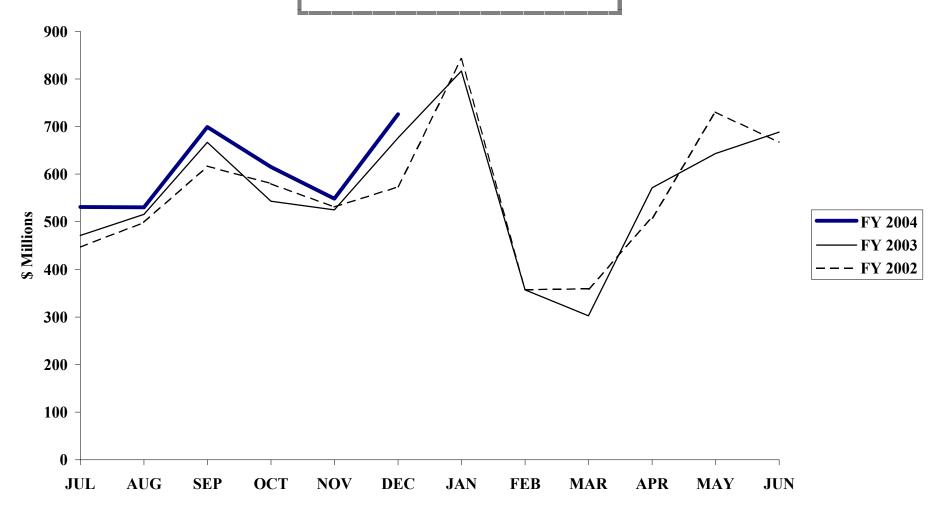

Net Individual Income Tax

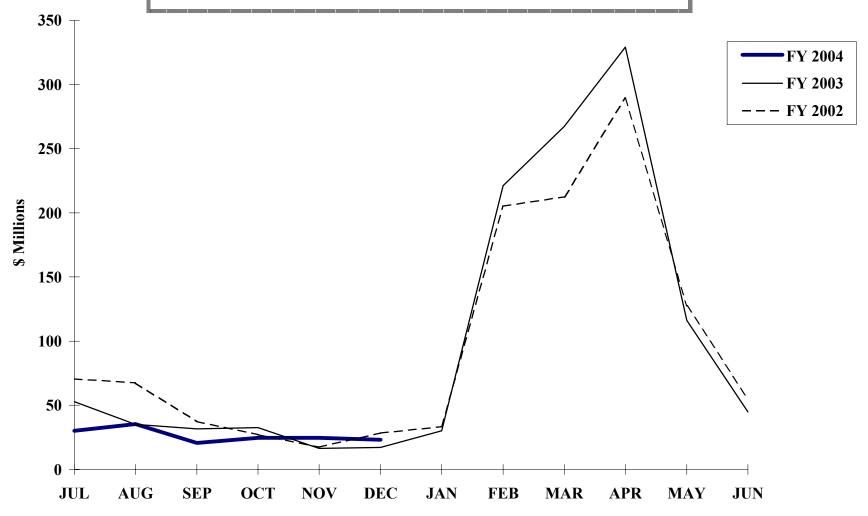
